In Joshua 2:10, God's Word says, "And there arose another generation after them who did not know the Lord or the work that he had done for Israel"

D.L. Moody had come back from a tent revival meeting where he reported that 2 1/2 people were saved. Whoever he was talking to replied, "You mean, two adults and one child?" D.L. Moody responded, "No, two children and one adult. **When you save a child, you save a life—a whole life.**"

Do you think it is the job of the youth minister to encourage the youth? Sure, but who else? Should it be the parents? Should it be other youth? Should it be you - the body of Christ? I think all of the above! The old saying "It takes a community to raise a child" isn't far off. Where do they learn math? Where do they learn how to interact with others? Where do they learn to tell others about Christ? Where do they themselves learn life lessons about Christ or day to day living? Are they learning it in your home, church, school or the streets? More children are learning how to live life everywhere but the Christian home or the church setting. Nearly 80% of people in our churches today decided to follow Jesus before age 18 and 50% of them decided to follow Jesus before age 12.

What is your job as a member of Christ's Church? "GO..." They need to know that His church supports them. They are impressionable. They see what you are doing and not doing. How do we bring up a child in the way they should "GO" (Prov22:6) if we are not doing it with them? You should get to know the youth. They are fun! They will never learn more than they do at a young age. You should interact with the youth. Here are some ideas: Sit in their Sunday School class one Sunday; sit with them at 5:30 on Sunday night at the beginning of their SLAM program and have a snack with them. Learn their games and play with them. Play basketball after service, lunch can wait an extra 15-20 minutes. How about you show up when they are gathering for an outing and tell them to have fun and you would love to hear about their adventure. Getting to know the youth and let them know that they are important is a calling from Christ. "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these. Matt 19:14.

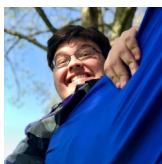


Mother: "How was the birthday party? I hope you didn't ask for a second piece of cake."
