United with Christ. Have you ever stopped and considered exactly what that means? The apostle Paul said “Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death?” A person who believes Christians are free to continue sinning, to do what they please, betrays a fundamental lack of understanding of what a Christian is. Christians are not just guilty sinners declared righteous by God because Christ has satisfied the demands of God’s righteousness on their behalf. That truth, which theologians call justification, is indeed an essential one. But there is much more to salvation than justification. Believers are also placed into union with Jesus Christ. Over and Over the Apostle Paul talks about this critical doctrine of being united with Christ. (Romans 6:3) What does our union with Christ mean in our everyday lives? First, it provides the means of fellowship with both Jesus and the Father (1 John 1:3). It also should motivate us to avoid sinning. In 1 Corinthians 6:15, Paul chided the Corinthians for their lax view of sexual sin: “Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take away the members of Christ and make them members of a harlot? May it never be!” Finally, our union with Christ provides hope of future glory (Rev. 3:21). We should be dead to sin and looking for that wonderful day of when “Our redemption” draws nigh. Much more could & should be said here but what a blessed privilege and awesome responsibility is ours, to have our lives bound with the Son of God (Col. 3:3)! Welcome to HCC.
