# WELCOME 3-17-2024

The Apostle Paul wrote "For this reason I bend *my knees before the Father, from whom every* family in heaven and on earth derives its name, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner self, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge . . . . (Eph. 3:14-19) One translation says I pray that all God's people will have the power to understand the greatness of Christ's love." From the cradle in Bethlehem to the cross in Jerusalem we have pondered the Love of our Heavenly Father. When we consider that God would rather die than live without us,

how do we react? We have a clue from the model prayer found in Matthew 6. Jesus began by exalting the Father: "Hallowed be Thy name" (v. 9), then requested that the Father's kingdom come and His will be done (v. 10). He concluded with an anthem of praise: "For Thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen" (v. 13). His prayer literally begins and ends with God. Isn't that what life should be like so *"we can know greatness of Christ's love?"* Each Sunday we come to give thanks for that great Love, to remember, to worship and celebrate the unexplainable passion of our Heavenly Father towards us.
