The prophet Isaiah wrote these words concerning our Savior: ". . . . Because He poured out himself to death " (Isaiah 53:12) Many have described the scene. The ground is cluttered with large rocks all surrounded by the darkness of the night. Among them a solitary figure, flat on his face, flat on the ground. His friends asleep not far away, (a stone's throw) and so were his enemies. His face stained with dirt and tears, so intense was his prayer the sweat became like "drops of blood". His plea in prayer "Father if you are willing remove this cup from me, yet not my will but Yours be done". The cup, death. We know who the figure in the darkness is, its Jesus. Someone said "Never was God more human than in those moments. Never was God nearer to us than when he hurt." That night in Gethsemane God "poured out himself to death". It is hard to comprehend.
