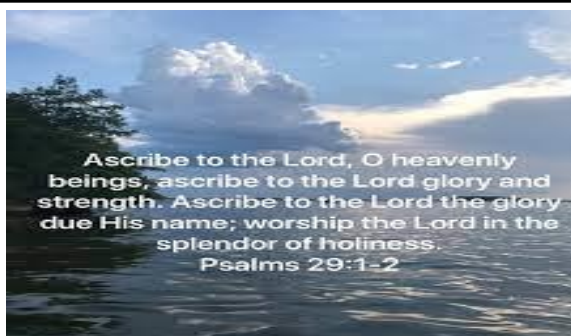


WELCOME 3-3-2024
