The Apostle Paul once told the church at Philippi "Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, as He already existed in the form of God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but emptied Himself by taking the form of a bondservant and being born in the likeness of men." Paul didn't make this statement from a theological perspective but from a practical one. He was referring to one of the characteristics of Jesus Christ. He gave up his rights! 


